We're pleased to announce that we are now accepting vendor/artisan and artist applications for the fifth annual Waking Persephone Underworld Ball, which will take place October 16th in Seattle, WA. We're looking for vendors, artisans, merchants, artists that cater to the darker side of the dance and the Goth and/or Steampunk culture... the more unique, the better! It doesn't have to be specifically dance-related, but it should fit in with the feel and theme of the event.

We will have just 6 spaces dedicated to artisans/vendors for the Ball. A space is \$50 and that includes a 6' foot table (or equal space if you don't need a table), 2 tickets to the Ball, and a listing and link on the event website - and promotion on the event page. As this event will feature 3 live bands (SJ Tucker, The Nathaniel Johnstone Band, The Ghost Project and a DJ / other entertainment) we're not only expecting to draw the Waking Persephone participants, but a much larger segment of the population (Steampunks, Pagans, etc) as we did last year.

The event will take place on Sunday October 16h at Hale's Brewery Palladium Theater and will run from 6:30-11pm. It is all ages and there is ample free parking. We can do load-in as early as 5pm. ***Since space is limited, we will be giving preference to exhibitors that we feel best fit the nature of the event, so please be specific in your business description, and send pictures or direct us to your website. Each year we jury our vendors to have the most interesting and diverse collection of shopping for our participants. PARTICIPATION IN A PREVIOUS WP EVENT DOES NOT GUARANTEE ACCEPTANCE. We limit the number of vendors to ensure we are offering the best selection and diversity of product to our participants. This means both new and returning vendors are jurried in the selection process every year.***
